## **MAY, 2005**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in May, 2005 was 31,076. This is a 0.25% increase from the 30,997 average inmate population in custody last month and a 1.6% increase from the average population (30,573) recorded one year ago. In May, 2005, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 21. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 31,097 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 49,064 was reported for the month of May, 2005, with 4,561 active parolees and 44,503 active probationers. This is a 0.4 % decrease from the 49,263 active caseloads reported last month.
