**Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in April, 2006 was 31,200. This is a 0.3% increase from the 31,098 average inmate population in custody last month and a 0.3% increase from the average population (30,997) recorded one year ago. In April, 2006, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 23. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 31,223 offenders.

**Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 53,843 was reported for the month of April, 2006, with 7,713 active parolees and 46,130 active probationers. This is a 0.3 % increase from the 53,673 active caseloads reported last month.
