## **JULY, 2007 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in July, 2007 was 31,893. This is a 0.9% increase from the 31,606 average inmate population in custody last month and a 2.8% increase from the average population (31,017) recorded one year ago. In July, 2007, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 39. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 31,932 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 57,190 was reported for the month of July, 2007, with 7,109 active parolees and 50,081 active probationers. This is a 0.4% increase from the 56,964 active caseloads reported last month.
