## **MARCH, 2008 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in March, 2008 was 33,229. This is a 0.5% increase from the 33,069 average inmate population in custody last month and a 6.1% increase from the average population (31,313) recorded one year ago. In March, 2008, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 52. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 33,281 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 58,930 was reported for the month of March, 2008, with 6,596 active parolees and 52,334 active probationers. This is a 0.09% increase from the 58,878 active caseloads reported last month.
