## **AUGUST, 2005**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in August, 2005 was 30,895. This is a 0.1% decrease from the 30,932 average inmate population in custody last month and a 0.4% increase from the average population (30,760) recorded one year ago. In August, 2005, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 23. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 30,918 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 52,452 was reported for the month of July, 2005, with 7,437 active parolees and 45,015 active probationers. This is a 0.4 % increase from the 52,230 active caseloads reported last month.
