SEPTEMBER, 2007 SUMMARY

Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in September, 2007 was 32,498. This is a 0.5% increase from the 32,326 average inmate population in custody last month and a 5.3% increase from the average population (30,871) recorded one year ago. In September, 2007, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 44. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 32,542 offenders.

Probation and Parole

A total caseload of 57,857 was reported for the month of September, 2007, with 6,999 active parolees and 50,858 active probationers. This is a 0.6% increase from the 57,523 active caseloads reported last month.
