## **JULY, 2008 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in July, 2008 was 33,349. This is a 0.5% increase from the 33,194 average inmate population in custody last month and a 4.6% increase from the average population (31,893) recorded one year ago. In July, 2008, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 342. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 33,691 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 59,044 was reported for the month of July, 2008, with 5,633 active parolees and 53,411 active probationers. This is a 0.1% increase from the 59,005 active caseloads reported last month.
