## **NOVEMBER, 2008 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in November, 2008 was 32,751. This is a 1.8% decrease from the 33,351 average inmate population in custody last month and a 0.2% increase from the average population (32,693) recorded one year ago. In November, 2008, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 418. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 33,169 offenders.
