OCTOBER, 2008 SUMMARY

Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in October, 2008 was 33,351. This is a 0.5% decrease from the 33,507 average inmate population in custody last month and a 2.2% increase from the average population (32,620) recorded one year ago. In October, 2008, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 418. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 33,769 offenders.

Probation and Parole

A total caseload of 59,423 was reported for the month of October, 2008, with 5,509 active parolees and 53,922 active probationers. This is a 0.04% increase from the 59,447 active caseloads reported last month.
