SEPTEMBER, 2008 SUMMARY

Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in September, 2008 was 33,507. This is a 0.5% increase from the 33,354 average inmate population in custody last month and a 3.1% increase from the average population (32,498) recorded one year ago. In September, 2008, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 334. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 33,841 offenders.

Probation and Parole

A total caseload of 59,447 was reported for the month of September, 2008, with 5,506 active parolees and 53,941 active probationers. This is a 0.6% increase from the 59,099 active caseloads reported last month.
