## **MAY, 2009 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in May, 2009 was 32,231. This is a 0.2% increase from the 32,161 average inmate population in custody last month and a 3.0% decrease from the average population (33,213) recorded one year ago. In May, 2009, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 406. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 32,637 offenders.
