## **APRIL, 2010 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions for April, 2010 was 29,959. This is a 0.4% increase from the 29,831 average inmate population in custody last month and a 6.8% decrease from the average population (32,161) recorded one year ago. For April, 2010, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 834. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 30,793 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 60,134 was reported for the month of April, 2010. This was a 0.4% decrease from the 60,399 reported for March, 2010.
