


Trend Analysis: VADOC PREA Hotline Referrals




NOTE: Projections developed by VADOC Statistical Analysis & Forecast Unit are based on actual referrals reported for January 2012 through February 2013; Projections do not take into account the scheduled opening of River North CC in Fall 2013 which will result in an increase in the VADOC Facility Population or the expected 0.8% growth in the State Responsible (SR) Population in FY2014 as detailed in the *SPS Report on the Offender Population Forecasts (FY2013-FY2018)*

PREA: Detecting, Reporting, Preventing

Offender – on – Offender Nonconsensual Sexual Acts


Contact between the penis and vagina or the penis and the anus including penetration, however slight; or contact between the mouth and the penis, vagina or anus; or penetration of the anus or genital opening of another person by a hand, finger or other object.



PREA: Detecting, Reporting, Preventing

Offender – on – Offender Abusive Sexual Acts


Intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh or buttocks of any person. Incidents in which the intention is to sexually exploit (rather than harm or debilitate).



PREA: Detecting, Reporting, Preventing

Staff Sexual Misconduct


Any behavior or act of a sexual nature, whether consensual or nonconsensual, directed towards an inmate by an employee, volunteer, official visitor or agency representative. Such acts include: intentional touching of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh or buttocks with the intent to abuse, arouse or gratify sexual desire; or completed, attempted, threatened, or requested sexual acts; or occurrences of indecent exposure, invasion of privacy or staff voyeurism for sexual gratification.



PREA: Detecting, Reporting, Preventing

Staff Sexual Harassment

Repeated verbal statements or comments of a sexual nature to an inmate by an employee, volunteer, official visitor or agency representative. Such statements include demeaning references to gender or derogatory comments about body or clothing; or profane or obscene language or gestures.

Corrective Actions

• Central Region

•Deep Meadow Correctional Center

- Mirrors installed in the kitchen

•Lunenburg Correctional Center

- Move position of the outside camera during mass movement to entrance and exit areas
- Provide refresher training to staff on appropriate shakedown procedures

•Powhatan Correctional Center

- B&G will review lighting schema in the dorms to determine a way to ensure they remain on at all times.
To be completed 2/28/14
- Staff that failed to report sexual assault allegation in a timely manner will be individually retrained on notification procedures by Assistant Warden
by 2/15/14
- A binder will be placed in each Watch Officer (PCC, M-Building, PRCC and PMU) with up to date notification procedures
- All departments will be required to discuss OP 038.3, Section, IV.E.2 – Staff Responsibilities and F. Responses by 2/28/14

Plant Modifications

- **Western Region**

- **Augusta Correctional Center**

- Curtains in from shower blocking view of genitalia from control room officers

- **Bland Correctional Center**

- Special Housing Shower doors installed to prevent viewing of offender genitalia
 - Curtains covering GP showers

- **Harrisonburg Men's Diversion Center**

- Swing doors installed on dorm bathrooms to prevent viewing of offender genitalia

- **Keen Mountain Correctional Center**

- Covers installed on shower doors to prevent viewing of offender genitalia

- **Marion Correctional Treatment Center**

- Swing doors installed on toilet stalls to prevent viewing of offender genitalia

- **Patrick Henry Correctional Unit #28**

- Commenced project to renovate basement bathroom with swing doors to prevent viewing of offender genitalia

- **Pocahontas State Correctional Center**

- Raised covers in front of showers in housing units to prevent viewing of offender genitalia while showering

- **Wallens Ridge State Prison**

- Swing doors installed in shower area to prevent view of offender genitalia while showering
