## **JANUARY, 2010 SUMMARY**

### **Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions**

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in January, 2010 was 30,475. This is a 1.4% decrease from the 30,911 average inmate population in custody last month and a 5.3% decrease from the average population (32,170) recorded one year ago. In January, 2010, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 216. The total average daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 30,691 offenders.

### **Probation and Parole**

A total caseload of 60,927 was reported for the month of January, 2010. This was a 0.25% increase from the 60,773 reported for December, 2009.
