

## **DOC Authorized Commuter List**

Commuting in a state vehicle is limited specific circumstances defined in <u>COV</u> §2.2-1178, *Use of passenger-type vehicles on an assigned basis*, <u>COV</u> §2.2-1179, *Use of vehicles for commuting*, Executive Order 89 (2005) *Purchase*, *Assignment and Use of State-Owned Vehicles*, and reiterated in the Office of Fleet Management Services Policies and Procedures Manual.

The following Department of Corrections positions are authorized to commute in a state vehicle.
