Average Daily Population in DOC Institutions

The average number of Virginia state responsible offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in November 2020 was 24,681. This is a 1.69% decrease from the 25,106 average Virginia inmate population in custody last month and a 15.87% decrease from the average population (29,336) reported one year ago. In November 2020, the average number of out of state offenders housed in contract beds was 50. The total average institutional daily population (ADP) in DOC institutions was 24,731 offenders.

The end of month Probation & Parole caseload for November 2020 was 67,935. This is a .01% decrease from the 67,939 reported for last month and a 2.43% decrease from the 69,626 offenders reported one year ago.
